.XXX SUNRISE BLOCKING OPTION FOR MARK OWNERS NOT IN THE ADULT ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY

ICANN recently approved .xxx as a new top-level domain (TLD) for adult industry websites. Given the nature of the TLD, the registry (ICM Registry) for the .xxx TLD has developed a "sunrise" rights protection mechanism for brand owners not in the adult entertainment industry.

There will be a "sunrise" period (Sunrise B) during which an eligible trademark/service mark owner can "block" its mark from being registered as a .xxx domain name. Sunrise B will last from September 7, 2011 through October 28, 2011.

Only owners, licensees or assignees of trademarks/service marks registered on or before September 1, 2011 will be eligible for a Sunrise B blocking registration. The trademark/service mark registration must be of national or regional international effect. Only an exact match of a registered trademark/service mark will be eligible for a blocking registration. Substantial matches cannot be registered during Sunrise B. Marks registered on the Supplemental Register are not eligible for a Sunrise B blocking registration.

There will be a one-time fee by ICM to cover the submission of a blocking registration. The specific fee is estimated to be between \$200 and \$300.

Brand owners who do not own a trademark/service mark registration that qualifies for a Sunrise B blocking registration may register for a blocking registration during the open registration phrase. That phase begins December 6, 2011.
