## **U.S. TAXATION**

Our attorneys advise foreign shipowners as to exemptions from U.S. federal taxation under Section 883 of the Internal Revenue Code, U.S. flag shipowners and operators relating to the U.S. tax consequences of their ownership and operation of vessels, including those resulting in participation in the Maritime Security Program and applicability of the U.S. tonnage tax regime.
