He also has represented Veterans before the United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims on a reduced fee basis and regularly provides pro bono services in Washington, D.C. and Virginia.

- Represented Veteran in the United States Court of Appeal for Veterans Claims seeking disability benefits for wartime service connection.
